- take action to increase policymaker focus on child care issues.
- provide a visual representation of just how many working individuals depend upon reliable,
- high-quality child care to maintain employment and peace-of-mind.

Opportunities for Company/Organization/Individual Participation

Group Photo

Company/Organization invites employees who depend upon child care to gather in the tent to show how many of them do so to work. Employees may wear event colors (blue and orange) and hold official event signage (provided by Trying Together) to add to the visual impact. Employers may share the group photo in internal/external communications on (or near) event date.

Lunch Break Takes (Story Sharing and Social Media Pics)

Employees from downtown/area companies/organizations who depend upon child care may choose a convenient time over the lunch break to visit the tent for photos and to share quick stories of the positive impact high-quality child care provides for work-life balance, child development, peace of mind, etc. We invite those who wish to participate to wear event colors (blue and orange) and hold official event signage to add to the visual impact.
