Mission Trying Together supports high-quality care and education for young children by providing advocacy, community resources, and professional growth opportunities for the needs and rights of children, their families, and the individuals who interact with them. Trying Together works regionally (in Southwestern Pennsylvania) and takes its expertise and models to statewide and national audiences.

Through 2022, Trying Together is committed to implementing its Strategic Plan.

In support of these goals, Trying Together:

- Became lead organization for Homewood-Brushton Family Support Center where staff work with more than 100 families to strengthen parenting practices.
- Engages several hundred families and home-based providers with programs facilitated by The Homewood Early Learning Hub.
- Provides more than 1,000 annual hours of professional development.
- Helped Allegheny County improve to a 97% on-time kindergarten registration rate as a partner on the “Hi5!” campaign.
- Is a steering partner on three statewide advocacy campaigns to support access and affordability to high-quality pre-kindergarten (Pre-K for PA), child care (Start Strong PA), and home visiting (Childhood Begins At Home) programs which have collectively secured increased investments of more than \$100 hundred million dollars.
- Is actively pursuing its newest work to help families make decisions that best support healthy development for the young children in their lives. More details will be available in 2019.
