

PA School-Age Professional Credential 2020-2021

The Pennsylvania School-Age Professional Credential is a competency based program modeled after the Child Development Associate (CDA). It provides individuals working in school-age programs the opportunity to examine their work in relation to the Pennsylvania School-Age Care Competency Standards.



ATTENTION PROVIDERS! A School Age Professional Credential (SAPC) Course is available online, starting October 20, 2020 to May 18, 2021. The Course will meet on Tuesdays from 6:30 PM – 8:30 PM and there will be a “do at your own pace” weekly assignment that should take two hours to complete.

What are the eligibility requirements?

- ⊙ Must be working in a Department of Human Service regulated program working with school-age children (5-12 years-old).
- ⊙ Must have a minimum of a high school diploma or GED credential.
- ⊙ Completed individual professional development plan
- ⊙ Must have worked at least 480 hours with school-age children in the
