

Feb 15th - March 29th HATCH ART+PLAYDATES


Join us this winter for **Playdates with Hatch**,

Feb 15 Not a Box:

Explore the concept of transformation using loose parts, a cardboard box, and simple tools like masking tape, a stapler, and scissors.

Feb 22 Making Marks:

Discover the many ways artists can make a mark by combining everyday household objects, paint, and various natural materials to make our own paintbrushes.

March 1 What Can we Build?

Save up your recyclables for this celebration of sculpture and construction. Bring your clean recyclables, masking tape, and scissors – and a hot glue gun if you're in the ages 6-8 experience.

March 8 Let's Make a Map!

In this class, we will play BIG using cardboard, construction paper, tape, glue, and other collage materials! Vehicle enthusiasts will enjoy playing with this project for days on end!

March 15 Cook Up a Creation!

In this class, we will make our own salt dough using basic kitchen ingredients (flour, salt, water) and explore texture and mark making as well. Modeling and molding is just a click away!

March 22 Art that Moves:

For kids that love to move and wiggle and are fascinated by moving parts, come enjoy art that moves! You will need paint for this class.
