Through a series of workshops, FIRE provides fathers with the parenting, relationship, and communication skills they need to be involved, responsible, and committed fathers.

What to expect when you contact Goodwill:

- Review eligibility
- Complete orientation (in person, phone, virtual)
- Attend all workshops (27 hours)
- Participate in optional employment and training activities

Additional Program Benefits:

- Individual case management
- Financial literacy
- Incentives
- Employment services
- Private sessions with a social worker
- Transportation assistance

Eligibility:

Participants must be a father or father figure, age 18 years or older of a child 24-years-old or younger, and reside in Allegheny County.
