

# Professional Development Fee for Service

Public Professional Development Series (In Person or Virtual)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>\$120 per person (6-hour series)</li> <li>\$160 per person (8-hour series)</li> <li>\$300 per person (15-hour series)</li> </ul>
First Aid, Pediatric First Aid, CPR, and AED Training	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>\$70 per person (includes cost of American Red Cross card)</li> </ul>
