

Registration is Now Open for the Woodland Hills Pre-K Counts Program



Woodland Hills School District provides a FULL DAY (Mon.– Fri. 9:15 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.) **PA Pre-K Counts Program** (180 days) for the 2025-26 school year. This program is free to residents whose children are three (3) or four (4) years old and fully potty trained by September 1, 2025 **AND** gross household income is within 300% of federal poverty level. What to expect from Woodland Hills Pre-K Counts classroom?

Woodland Hills Pre-K Counts classrooms will:

- have teachers with the education and expertise to teach young children;
- use a curriculum that will help your child grow academically and socially;
- regularly review your child's progress and choose teaching and learning activities that are best for your child;
- help you and your child adjust to pre-kindergarten and smoothly move on to kindergarten; and
- offer a small class size (18 students per one teacher and one teacher aide) so that your child can have plenty of one-on-one time with the teachers.

By enrolling your child in the Woodland Hills Pre-K Counts Program, you can give your child a great start to a bright future.
