The child care staffing shortage is driven by low wages. Wages are so low in Indiana County that they fail to meet the cost of living.

The General Assembly and Administration must increase funding for the Child Care Staff Recruitment and Retention Program to prevent more classrooms from closing and further limiting availability for working families in need of care.
